



The MOBILE software on a mobile unit is used to track responders, evacuees, patients, and equipment as they move throughout the scene. MOBILE ICS is used for incident management functions.

A MOBILE UNITS

- 1 - Power on the MOBILE Unit
- 2 - Start > Settings > System tab
 - Check Date, Time and Time Zone
- 3 - Start > Settings > Connections tab > Connection Icon > Advanced Tab > Select Networks
 - Check to confirm that the setting for internet and private connections is 'My Work Network'
- 4 - From the main screen (WM2003) Network Icon > Status > Signal or (WM5, 6) Network Icon > Wireless Status > Current Profile
 - Check to confirm that the MOBILE unit is connected to fireTRAX

Note: If the battery is dead see the MOBILE User Guide for complete setup information.

B MOBILE ICS

- 1 - Tap on the MOBILE icon
- 2 - Tap on the ICS tab
- 3 - Tap on Menu > New Incident
- 4 - Add an incident number (not required) and choose a Type from the dropdown
- 5 - Scan an assignment barcode and scan a person or piece of equipment
