



rapidTAG is used to identify responders, volunteers, etc. rapidTAG registers people by reading data off their driver's licenses or through manually entering the data and then prints a barcoded temporary site-specific ID tag.

A ZEBRA PRINTER

- 1 - Best practice is to attach all cables into the same ports as those used during installation
- 2 - Plug the printer into the power source and turn it on
- 3 - Verify that the media is on the roll in the dispenser
- 4 - Check the ribbon for proper seating.

B ESEK & Mobile unit SCANNER

- 1 - Plug the ESEK or tethered scanner into the appropriate USB or Serial Port.

C rapidTAG

- 1 - Double click on the rapidTAG icon
- 2 - Click on Start
NOTE: If you wish to choose an incident name or number rather than use the one that appears, you must make the change prior to clicking on Start
- 3 - Choose the Responder, Equipment, Company or Organization tab and click on Add.
- 4 - Manually enter the information. For personnel you may also scan a driver license, interTRAX™ barcode, or military ID.
- 5 - Click on Finish when input is complete.
