INTRODUCTION

With Salamander's INVENTORY APP solution, you can quickly and accurately track the issuance and return of equipment used during an event.

PRE-WORK BEFORE COMPLETING THIS EXERCISE

This exercise is tied to data associated with Salamander's SalamanderLive™ training account. In order to complete the scenario, you will need a login. To request access, email training@salamanderlive.com.

SCENARIO USING THE INVENTORY APP SOLUTION

The following scenario is designed to be used with a smart phone installed with the INVENTORY APP software, connectivity to the internet, and the INVENTORY APP login provided to you by training@salamanderlive.com.

EVENT

Your team is responding to an earthquake that collapsed a portion of an office building in Sacramento, CA.

YOUR ASSIGNMENT

You are stationed at the Staging area and are assigned to track equipment being used during the event with the INVENTORY APP. An event has already been started in the TRACK APP called "Midtown Sacramento Office Earthquake Response – TEST". All equipment issuances should be linked to this event.

SCENARIO EXECUTION

Start the INVENTORY APP

- Start the INVENTORY APP and login using the credentials provided to you by training@salamanderlive.com.

Issue Inventory

- Three responders have arrived on-scene and are going to utilize several pieces of equipment that you need to issue out to them. These issuances should be linked to the event.

Scan TAGs:

 - Radio 1
 - Full Face Respirator 1
 - Laptop
- Billy Sharpe
 - Radio 2
 - Pelican 9430 Light

Manually Add:

- April Moore
 - Radio 3
 - Face Shield
 - Fire Extinguisher 1

- An ambulance has arrived on-scene. It was previously marked out of service due to a maintenance issue that has since been resolved. However, SalamanderLive was not yet updated to properly reflect the status change. Issue the items and their quantities to Frank DeRosa and link it to the event.

Scan TAGs:

- Frank DeRosa
 - Ambulance
 - N95 Dust Mask
 - Poly-coated Tyvek Suit

Manually Add:

- Emergency Blanket (10)
- First Aid Kit

Return Inventory

- April Moore and Billy Sharpe are ready to end their shift and need to return all their equipment. During the event, a couple of the items malfunctioned and will need to be marked as out of service.

Scan TAGs:

- Billy Sharpe
 - Radio 2
 - Pelican 9430 Light (Out of Service)

Manually Add:

- April Moore
 - Radio 3
 - Face Shield
 - Fire Extinguisher 1 (Out of Service)
