

RAPID TAG SCENARIO EXERCISE



INTRODUCTION

During an event, all personnel must be checked-in and receive an assignment regardless of their organization affiliation or purpose at the event. Salamander's RAPID TAG solution provides a quick and accurate method for Staging Managers to create an event specific ID TAG for first responders, volunteers, and media who are not part of the initially responding organization and do not have a Salamander ID TAG.

SCENARIO USING THE RAPID TAG SOLUTION

The following scenario is designed to be used with a computer installed with the RAPID TAG software, a tethered scanner that is configured with the software, and the RAPID TAG Quick Start Guide. To save your printing supplies, set the default printer to print to PDF.

EVENT

The Moosewood Police Department is dispatched to a search and rescue of a little boy who is lost during a hike with his family in the Appalachian Trail.

YOUR ASSIGNMENT

You are stationed at the staging area and are assigned to check people in using RAPID TAG as they await their assignment from the Resource Managers.

SCENARIO EXECUTION

Start RAPID TAG

- Ensure the tethered scanner is configured and connected.
- Ensure RAPID TAG is synced to SalamanderLive™ (or COMMAND).
- Ensure PDF is selected as the printer default.

Start a New Event

- Start a new event and name it "SAR – AT Test".

Check in Resources

- Check in the team from Moosewood Police Department.

Send Data to SalamanderLive

- To ensure all the resources you have checked in are received by SalamanderLive (or COMMAND), manually click "SEND".

Check Out Resources

As resources prepare to go off-scene, it is a best practice to make sure each resource physically goes to a check out location. With RAPID TAG, this can be done by scanning their IDs (driver's license or RAPID TAG ID) a second time or by editing their record and manually changing their assignment to Off-Scene.

End the Event

- Once all resources in RAPID TAG have been moved to the Off-Scene assignment, send any queued data to SalamanderLive (or COMMAND).
- End the event.
- A detailed report for the event can be viewed in SalamanderLive (or COMMAND).

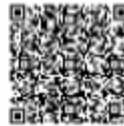
